Lates-to-School affect the individual students' ability to be academically successful and an individual's Lates-to-School disrupt the learning of the entire class.

"Attendance - In order to succeed in school, regular attendance is a must. If a student is absent for any reason, a written note of explanation from a parent/guardian or doctor is required. If a student misses too many classes, whether it is due to illness, a medical condition, appointments, vacations, and even with parental permission, their school year may be in jeopardy. It is recognized that days absent can occur for a number of legitimate reasons and that a student with effort and "catch-up" time can maintain their marks to a point. However absenteeism beyond a certain point (warning letters will be sent home) will not allow a student to demonstrate the learning expectations as stated by the Ontario Ministry of Education. Late to school and/or late to class is a form of absence and it will affect marks and school performance as well. Excessive lates can also result in their school year (courses) being in jeopardy. If marks and/or school performance are being negatively affected by a child's absenteeism, parents will be notified by letter at each level of absenteeism."

First Notice: Please improve your punctuality so that you arrive to school with sufficient time to be in class, prior to the commencement of the national anthem, fully prepared and ready to begin.

Second Notice: Lates-to-School beyond this point will reduce your level of success in each of your first period subject and will make it increasingly difficult to demonstrate the learning expectations of your grade.

Third Notice: Lates-to-School to date have put the earning of promotion at risk and you will be required to wait at the office until your teacher has his/her class working and your tardiness does not interfere with the class's learning.

Final Notice: Lates-to-School to date have put the earning of promotion in jeopardy and you will not be admitted into class until the beginning of the next period and you will be recorded as absent.
