## **Scholars' Dollars**

At the end of every month all the teachers and administration will determine how many Scholars' Dollars your son or daughter has earned for you as a result of meeting or exceeding the Scholars' criteria listed on each Scholars' Dollar.

Scholars' Dollars provide you with a monthly evaluation of how successfully your child has met the Scholars' criteria.

Scholars' Dollars provide you and your child an insight into the areas of citizenship that are strong and those areas that could be improved.

The monthly earning of Scholars' Dollars allows your child to directly contribute to his/her education at Scholars' Hall.

Save these Scholars' Dollars from each month and use them (same as cash) towards your child's tuition for the following year.

### **How Scholars' Dollars are earned . . .**

- \* Respect for Self = \$5 (full and proper uniform, worn neatly at all times)
- \* Respect for Peers = \$5 (friendly, supportive & positive interaction)
- \* Respect for Adults = \$5 (mannerly, courtesy, respectful of authority)
- \* Academic = \$5 per subject - maximum four subjects (improved academic performance)
  
- ^ HomeWork = \$5 (5 or less homework strikes); \$10 (no home work strikes)
- ^ Attendance = \$5 (one absent/late in a month); \$10 (perfect monthly attendance)
- ^ Community Involvement = \$5 (participation, clubs, fundraisers, volunteerism)
- ^ Leadership = \$10 (active self initiative in school community)

**Student-in-Good-Standing** = \$5

Retained - no office trips, less than 10 homework strikes and less than 5 days absent in the month)

**Scholar-of-the-Month** = \$15

- 1) must earn Scholars' Dollars in a minimum of  $\frac{3}{4}$  from first group (\*)  
(Respect for Self; Peers; Adults and/or Academic)
- 2) must earn Scholars' Dollars in a minimum of  $\frac{3}{4}$  from the second group (^)  
(HomeWork; Attendance; Community Involvement and/or Leadership)

\* maximum annual Scholars' Dollars that can be used to reduce the next year's tuition is \$700.
